Here are some examples of items to purchase for a box:

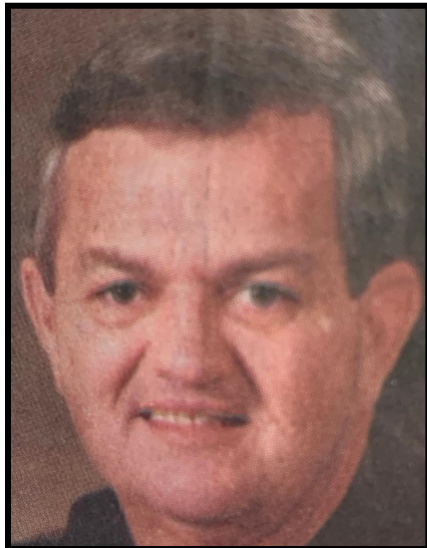
Toothbrush (please keep it in its original package)
