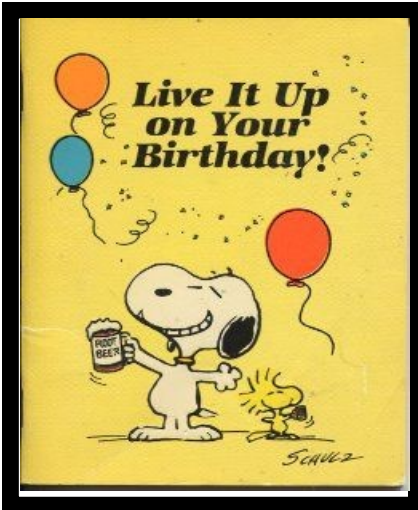

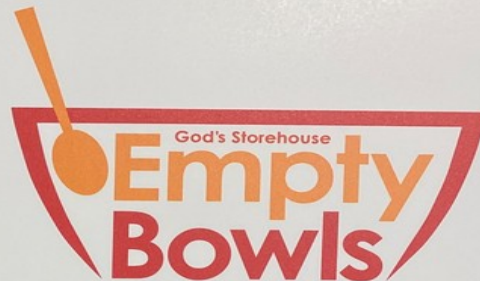
Remember Ash Wednesday is on February 22nd this year. Start praying and planning now on your sacrifice to the Lord. Remember what He did for us—laid down His life!

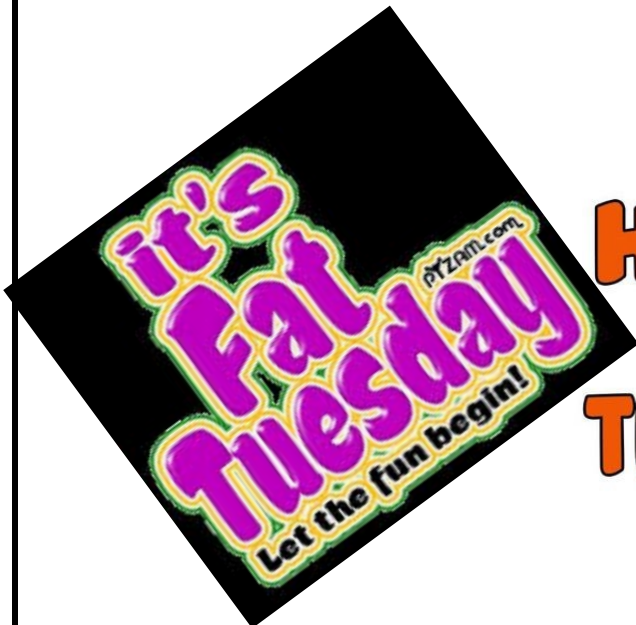
