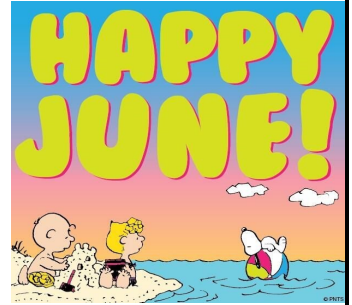

Please see a member of the Men’s Group for tickets—\$10/each.

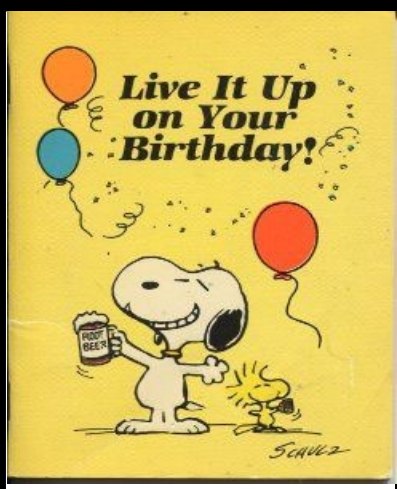
